I have served as a Volunteer Chaplain for nearly a quarter of a century (24 years since
1980) for the prisons and juvenile halls in Los Angeles. This year alone approximately
25,000 youths will be detained in juvenile halls in Los Angeles County. Painfully true.
Our kids need mentors, role models, and influential materials that will guide them in the
right direction. These hurt, depressed, & overwhelmed youth and adults have found hope
with the *Chat with God, Prayer Journal*...aka the “purple book.”

The Probation Department, which operates the juvenile halls, is facing \$100 million in
budget cuts this year...our sponsorship from supporting churches is also waning. Thus,
we are deeply in need. The budget cuts will likely lead to increasing numbers of at-risk
youth becoming involved with crime if they have no alternative hope.

This significant prayer journal brings hope to these hopeless hearts. This diary allows
inmates to write down their confessions, dreams, and prayers while entrusting them to
God. This commitment leads them to do the right thing. It allows them to look back 6
months...a year later and realize their progress...where they were...and where they are
today. Each youth or adult inmate that receives a journal gets to take the prayer journal
home with them...to help them with the transition from incarceration life to life in the
real world. The journal can impact their family and the world around them. This is
happening today, but to continue we need your help.

This project is worthy of your support. I have an opportunity to work one on one with
these youth, teach Pro Per Class (smart enough to be Jr. Lawyers), Bible Class, Mental
Service Bureau Class, to the mentally ill incarcerated. These inmates are begging for

copies of this prayer journal that is self-directing and works together with the Bible...a life manual...a tool that is powerful...God breathed. We need 25,000+ journals a year just to serve the juvenile hall in L.A. alone. We have requested a special printing in paperback without spiral binding in English.
